

Cemetery Rules and Regulations

- The cemetery reserves the right to repurchase any lot or any part of a lot, at original cost, if a transfer is contemplated to anyone other than a member of the immediate family of the owner.
- Trees may not be planted in any lot.
- All other plantings must be approved by the Cemetery Board.
- During mowing season all flowers, other than funeral flowers, should be placed within six (6) inches of stones of the East edge lots only.
- Glass containers are not to be used in the cemetery.
- No railings, curbing or fences will be permitted.
- Corner Posts will be set with tops at ground level, without disturbing original surveyor's markers.
- Individual and double markers of granite, marble or bronze must be set on pre-poured concrete foundations with tops level with the ground for ease of mowing. Depth of marker foundations must be at least 12".
- Monuments must be installed on pre-poured concrete foundations on the East edge of the lot and at least 9" from adjoining plots. Depth of monument foundations must be at least 20".
- All stone foundations must be staked by a cemetery official. The cemetery reserves the right to insist on pouring monument and marker foundations if a monument dealer does not comply with cemetery regulations regarding foundation preparation.
- The cemetery is not responsible for damage to monuments or markers or the theft of flowers, flower holders, vases, etc.
- All Christmas decorations will be removed after March 1st.
